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1.Barclays Bank - Sort Code * 20-17-68 *

The University's current Barclay's Bank Sort Code 20-17-19 and IBAN have now changed the new sort code **20-17-68** is now in operation. There will be no changes to account numbers.

Payments received from our customers / students / suppliers / donors etc using the old sort code will continue to work for 3 years, so whilst we need to ensure our details are updated promptly we are not at immediate risk of missing out on receiving payments.

Cheques issued to our suppliers / students / customers etc will still be honoured by the bank.

CUFS documents, eg sales invoices, statements, dunning letters etc have been updated with the new bank details.

New 'Paying-in books' are being distributed to departments today via the UMS. Any completely unused paying-in books with the old sort code should be destroyed once you have received the new one.
