There are three new GL reports available in Cognos. These reports can be found in the Departmental (Shared) reports folder for your school. Documentation on how to run these reports can be obtained from the *Finance Training webpages* > *Guidance & FAQs* > *General Ledger*. There is also a guide to setting up a Cognos <u>Report View</u> in the *Cognos* section, if you would like to save your parameters for any of these reports.

- GL: Budget to Actual
- GL: Financial Summary

They have been designed to replace the current suite of GL reports and have runtime options that allow you alter the output of the report to suit your needs. 5. Reminder - CUFS Minimum Client Java Requirements Changed 31st October

With effect from Wednesday 31st Oct 2018 the minimum recommended/supported version of Java for CUFS increased to version 1.8.0_181. This means that PC's or MAC's used by CUFS users must have a version of Java installed at version 1.8.0_181 or later versions of Java version 8.
