CUFS vulnerability – Thursday 21 May

iProcurement - Temporary suspension of 'Deliver to Home' (DTH) orders

We regret to inform that 'Delivery to Home' (DTH) orders are temporarily suspended until 26 May while we investigate an issue. Please **do not use** this code in the interim for any new orders,. Unfortunately, we are unable to deactivate this code in the interim as this will impact on the ability to receipt existing orders. We apologise for any inconvenience this causes.

As a reminder, when this process restarts next week users must place all DTH-orders via the non-catalog route. Orders placed via the Marketplace to your home address cannot be transmitted in full to suppliers and will cause delays to receiving goods. Orders to University locations can continue to be placed via the Marketplace.

Furlough of staff funded from research grants
