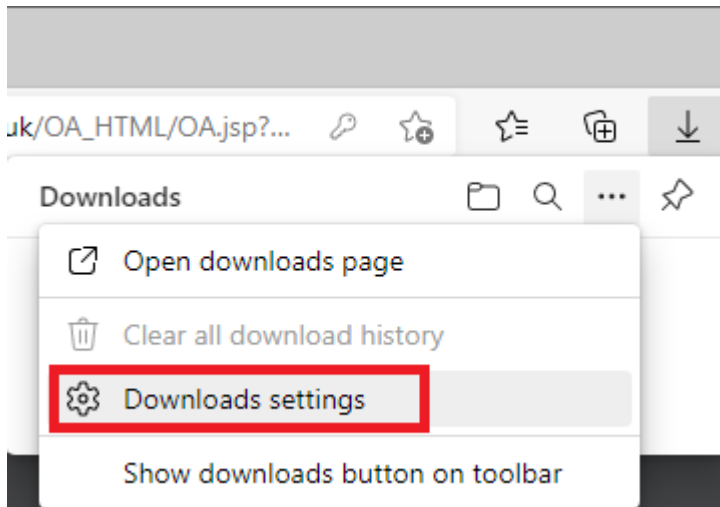


Downloading Excel files from CUFS in Edge

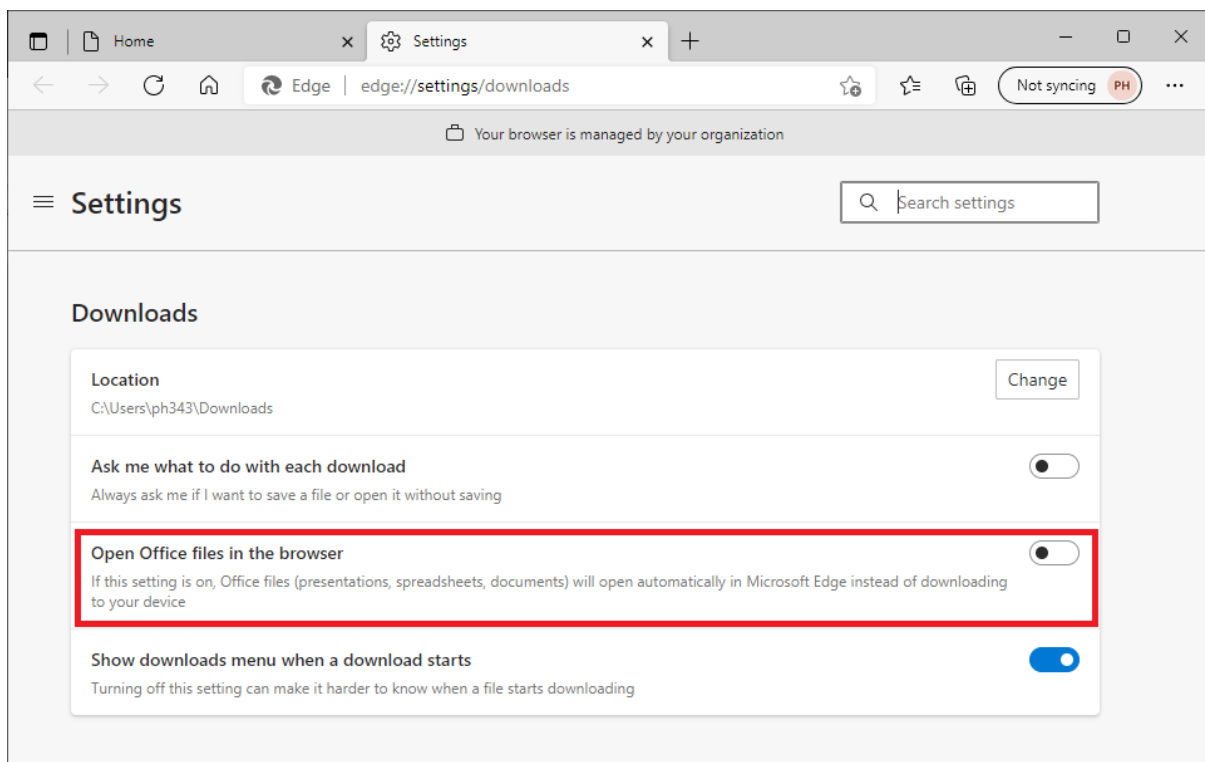
Open Edge, from the ... menu, select **Downloads**.
