# 4. Finance Systems Update

#### **Paul Humphreys**

- Passphrases to replace CUFS passwords From July 2018 all CUFS passwords will need to be 13 characters or more, as a guide users should choose three words that have meaning to them but not easily guessed. The passphrase will not expire like the current passwords. You must keep your passphrase and user name secure do not share them. You must reset your passphrase immediately if you suspect this has become known by others.
- RG Re-numbering CUFS is running out of RG numbers. During August/September 2018 the
  numbering will change from RG123456 to G123456. The changes effect CUFS, Reporting, RCO
  database, X5 and CHRIS. If you are aware of other impacts please email
